## Install FormPort Designer

- 1. Download FormPort Designer from <u>ftp.iocorp.com/FormPort/FPDesigner.zip</u> to a temporary directory on the PC's hard disk.
- 2. Unzip the downloaded file.
- 3. Run the setup.exe file. Follow the installation program prompts. A new program group called FormPort will be added.
- 4. Launch FormPort Designer. The designer has been installed as a fully functional demo. Forms may be created, edited and downloaded to the I-O 3235F CompactFlash. Print jobs that use the form will contain a "not licensed" watermark.

## License FormPort Designer

1. On the menu bar, select Help | Register FormPort Designer...

2. In the Identification Key section, copy the Identification Key number.

3. Send the Identification Key number to your I-O dealer.

- 4. The dealer will send a purchase order to I-O Corporation for a FormPort Designer license. The purchase order must include the Identification Key number, company name, address, telephone, end-user contact, and e-mail address for the contact.
- 5. I-O will send the license key to the dealer via e-mail.
- 6. The dealer will provide the license key to the customer.
- 7. The customer will activate the live version of the designer by pasting the license key in the Help | Register FormPort Designer.... | Validation Key field. Clicking the Register button completes the process.

However, forms that were downloaded to the I-O 3235F prior to licensing will need to be recompiled in the designer to remove the watermark.
